Strong marriages make strong families. This class trains marriage mentors to be confident in mentoring couples. Mentors will be equipped with facilitation skills and trained to use a professional assessment tool to help couples discover strengths and growth points in their relationship. Upon class completion, participating couples are expected to serve as marriage mentors.

Note: This course is for couples who are at least 5 years in their marriage. Both must be in Step D. Couples attending this course must have already completed their Prepare & Enrich assessment. If not, they are required to do an online assessment and meet the trainers before the commencement of the course. Enrolment is subjected to pastoral leaders' approval. An e-mail will be sent to notify you on the status of your registration. Kindly give some time for the application to be processed.



ALPHA PARENTING FOR TEENAGERS

This course is for any parent or carer of teenagers, a single parent or a step-parent. It is designed to empower parents to be the best parent they can be to teenagers aged 11-18 years.

Over five sessions, the course will help you to:

- Keep your long term aim in mind
- Meet your teenager's needs
- Set clear boundaries
- Develop emotional health
- Help them make good choices

While the foundations are based on Christian principles, it is also suitable for non-Christians as the course provides skills and methods on parenting but does not require the participant to know scripture. Many non-Christian parents have benefited from the program and enjoyed the sessions.

SHORT-TERM MISSION FACILITATOR TRAINING

Want to be involved in Missions and contribute as a STM Facilitator, coordinating and facilitating teams of STM candidates, or even your own Life Group?

This STM Facilitator Course will provide the necessary training in the following areas:

- 1. Logistic Track** – Planning for travel in post-covid world, dealing with emergencies and crisis
- 2. Ministry Preparation** – Preparing team, cultural sensitivity, relating to field workers and ministry tools
- 3. Devotional Track** – Facilitating spiritual atmosphere and preparing devotion that effect change in lives
- 4. Mentoring Track** – Effectively mentoring team and how to do daily debrief

This training includes a **compulsory STM trip as an On-Job-Training (OJT)** after the 3 sessions in class and will be conducted by YWAM instructors. All sign up participants are expected to be a volunteer of the STMFM after the training and will be required to facilitate at least 1 STM trip within the 2 years after the training. Sign up to be part of God's team to facilitate the work of His heartbeat for the nations.

STM trip details

Estimated cost:

\$750 to \$900 (air tickets, accommodation, transport, meals), depending on cost of air tickets.

Note: STM fees are paid fully by participants. Church planter returnees and those that led STM for at least 3 times can be exempted from this STM trip training.

Tentative STM dates:

Dates will be updated on Grow Portal. STM destination will be pre-determined by organiser.

Pre-requisites:

Participants should be at least a Step D Mentor and above. For students, participants must be at least 21 years old. Participants are expected to serve as a STM Facilitator volunteer in the STM Facilitator Ministry (STMFM) and facilitate at least 1 STM within the 2 years after the training.
